"Automatic" indicates that new membership will start immediately from sign-up

"Automatic" indicates that new membership end date will be calculated according to the start date and the membership duration

Pro rate price should pro rate either:
• The CiviCRM membership fee if "fee" field is not enabled or
• The membership fee field for that membership if selected.

To Note:

- 1) We do not change the renewal process for existing membership
- 2) We only take into account active memberships when evaluating the relative start and end date.
- 3) If end date is in the past for all of the evaluated membership types then user should not be able to buy the related add on. We should show an error message. "Unfortunately you cannot purchase this item as your membership has expired".
